Painting and Mural

Painting and mural workshop was a daylong event scheduled on 24th September 2019. The explanation and presentation part of the workshop was conducted in the seminar hall and the practical workshop was held in the workshop hall of the institute. Eminent artist of the city Mr. Milind Limbekar was invited for conducting the painting part of the workshop. He is masters in painting and has won many prominent awards along with a fellowship for his outstanding work in painting.

Students from the B.Arch. and B.Des. both batches participated in the workshop. Students were informed well in advance to arrange their own painting material.


Mr. Milind Limbekar shared his knowledge, experience and expertise with students wholeheartedly and in a very friendly manner. He taught painting on canvas to the students through the presentation. He also demonstrated a few techniques of canvas painting and asked students to explore the same for creating their own textures out of it. He emphasized on experimentation more than on creating something preconceived.

All the students curiously learnt the techniques and tried their hand in painting in the workshop itself. At the end of the first half the paintings of the students were exhibited in the large corridor of the institute and the winners were felicitated. Three winners were chosen based on their experimentation and efforts taken during applying paint on the canvas.

The winners at the 1st 2nd and 3rd position were Ms. Palak Agrawal, Ms. Devashri Naigaonkar and Ms. Nandini Agrawal respectively.

















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The Second half was dedicated to mural workshop and the session was conducted by Mr. Mouktik Kate. He is a qualified sculptor and has won many national level awards for his outstanding sculptures. He often uses to participate and exhibit his art in many national and international competitions.

Students from the B.Arch. and B.Des. both batches participated in this workshop also. Again the presentation and explanation part was conducted in the seminar hall and practical carving part was executed in the workshop hall of the institute. Students were informed in advance to arrange their own carving tool box.

Mr. Mouktik Kate started the session by a presentation on basic information about sculptures and about his own work. After the presentation and explanation part he actually demonstrated to the students the carving of mural from a cement foam brick. He then assigned an exercise to the students to try their mural making skill by carving simple geometric shapes on the cement foam brick. As a matter of safety students used face mask to protect themselves from the inconvenience that may cause because of the dust produced during carving. A lot of excitement, curiosity and performance anxiety was seen among the students.

End of the day the art work of the students was assessed and 3 winners were declared. Ms. Kajal Gaidhane, Mr. Pragat Devikar and Mr. Rushi Agrawal were declared winners of the workshop.

Both the workshops were highly appreciated by the students and they showed their willingness to attend more workshops like this in the future. The event was hosted by Associate Prof. Dr. Purva Mange and attended by all the students and faculties.
