BALSADAN ORPHANAGE

(AREGISTERED GOVT. ORGANIZATION)



Every child deserves to be taken care of and to have a home and family, so our group-3 went to a charity named "Balsadan" to contribute our share for these children. This charity is majorly operated from Nagpur and is located at katol road, Nagpur.

The main aim and objectives of this charity are to establish and maintain a "Home" for orphan from 6 to 20 years of age, plus destitute and abandoned girls irrespective of their religion, creed and caste. To give them personal care, emotional security, proper education and training facilities plus to provide them complete rehabilitation for a confident future. The Balsadan charity provides vocational training in sewing & stitching, computer centre and training in skin and beauty is running regularly since 2004. This charity also owns a wedding hall and schools and colleges in Panchkula and Chandigarh so that they receive a good amount of money for these children.



Since a greater number of children are school going particularly of age 13 to 15 years, the school itself provides (donates) all the needful material to them like books and other required stationary. But due to the pandemic, the charity and the schools were reeling through a loss. Hence some college students from Ramdev Baba college of Engineering went for tutoring at Balsadan (without expecting of fees).



Balsadan have two hostels, one distinctly for boys and the other for girls. The manager of the orphanage took us to the hostels for the donation of clothes to the children. We had two cartons and two bags full of clothes.

Details of donation:

1st carton: 43 clothes

2nd carton: 56 clothes

1st bag: 21 clothes

2nd bag: 18 clothes.

Finally Moved by the plight of the orphan and destitute children unloved, uncared for and no one to call their own, we have decided to visit the orphanage every month and hand out required things. So, giving is not just about making a donation but is about making a difference. So, let's make a difference by helping the needy. Let's make in India.
